



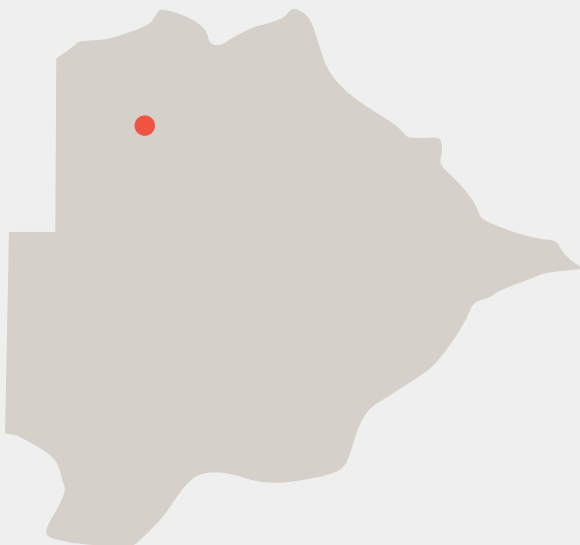

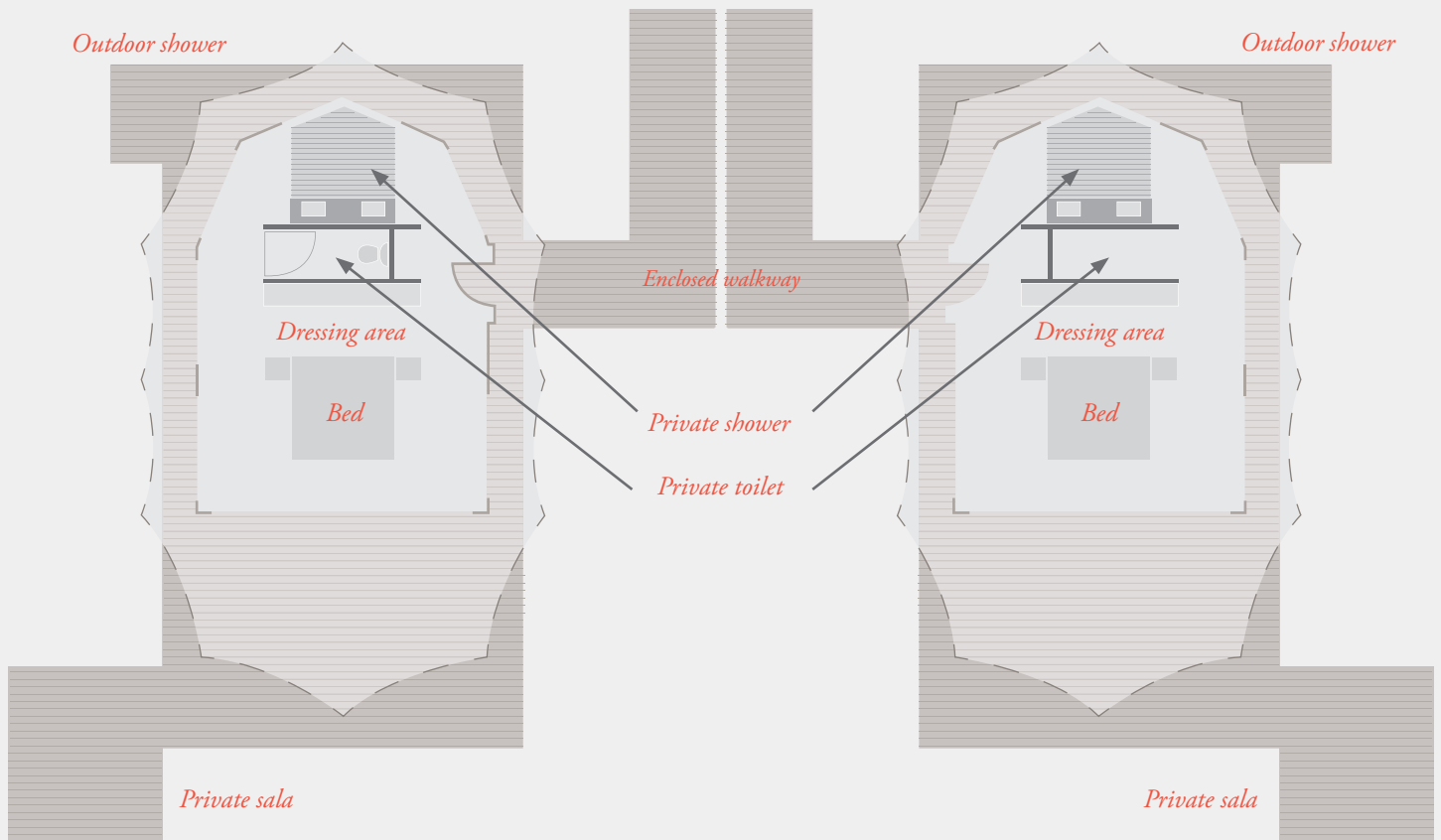
## WILDCHILD PROGRAMME

#### GAME DRIVE POLICY AT &BEYOND NXABEGA OKAVANGO TENTED CAMP







The below policy applies to children on shared game drives and boating activities\*.

AGE OF CHILD	GAME VIEWING PARTICIPATION**
0 – 2 years	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Not permitted on game viewing activities</li> </ul>
3 – 5 years	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Not permitted on game viewing activities; however, shortened children's game drives available on request</li> </ul>
6 – 11 years	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Permitted on game drives and boating activities, at the discretion of the lodge manager</li> <li>Not permitted on nature walks or mokoro activities</li> </ul>
12 – 16 years	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Permitted on game drives, nature walks and boating activities</li> <li>16 years and older permitted on mokoro excursions</li> </ul>

\*A private vehicle (subject to availability and at an additional cost) can be booked when staying at &Beyond Nxabega Okavango Tented Camp, allowing children of all ages to participate in a game drive. Access to sightings will be at the discretion of the guide, based on the behaviour of both the child and animals. Greater distances from animals may be adhered to, or certain sightings may be avoided, in order to ensure the safety of all. In the case of boating activities, the availability of boats may restrict private use and require forward planning.

\*\* Whilst there are age restrictions for children permitted on game viewing activities, all ages will be accommodated on game drive and boat transfers to-and-from the lodge.

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
