

So far, the Soneva team has identified 13 surfing spots in the Baa Atoll and 11 in the Noonu Atoll and hopes to uncover many more. Each of these locations is relatively unknown, meaning they are less traveled, less crowded and secret. Soneva says these secret surfing spots will only be revealed to resort guests who book the surfing package.

Soneva Fushi, located in a UNESCO-protected Biosphere Reserve, has 57 private villas each with their own stretch of beach and butler 24 water villas and one island villa, with additional island villas planned




